Friendly Reminders:
Please be sure to keep your properties weeds, high grass and other vegetation cut and removed according to ordinance 215.020. Grass should be kept under 8 inches, or it will be deemed as a nuisance.

Disposal of trash should be in the proper trash bins for pickup services. Any bulk items such as a couch or mattress will have to be coordinated through waste management for a bulk item pickup and must have a plastic cover over the item for pickup.
